We coordinates the Sierra Nevada Global Change Observatory that become a LTER site in 2008. We have wide experience in the design and implementation of environmental information systems. The local information system created for the Sierra Nevada LTER site (called linaria) has been also implemented in LBA (Large Scale Biosphere-Atmosphere Experiment) in Brazil

Our main interest in participating in EU BON is related to the transfer of the expertise that we have gathered when implementing our local LTER site. It will be very interesting for us to integrate our project within global initiatives such as EU BON.

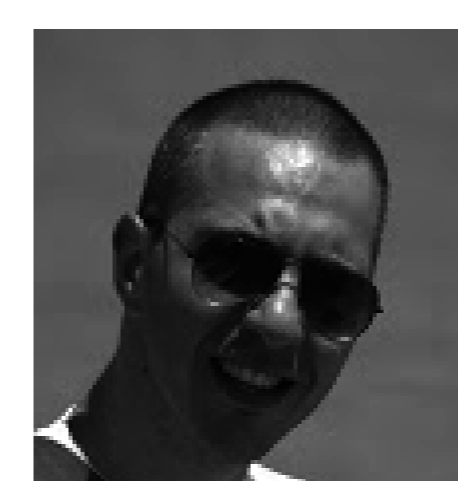
