

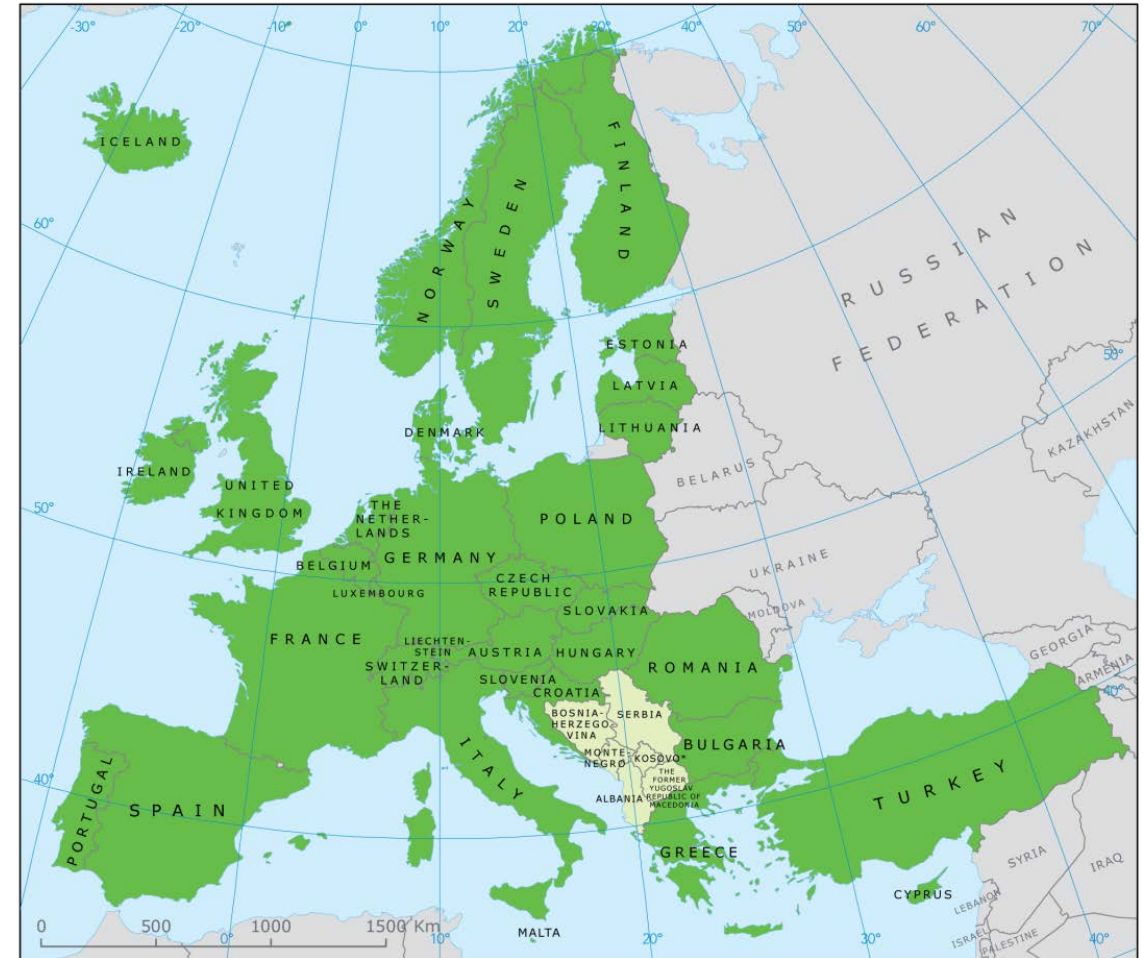

- Promote the integration of economic value of ecosystem services into accounting

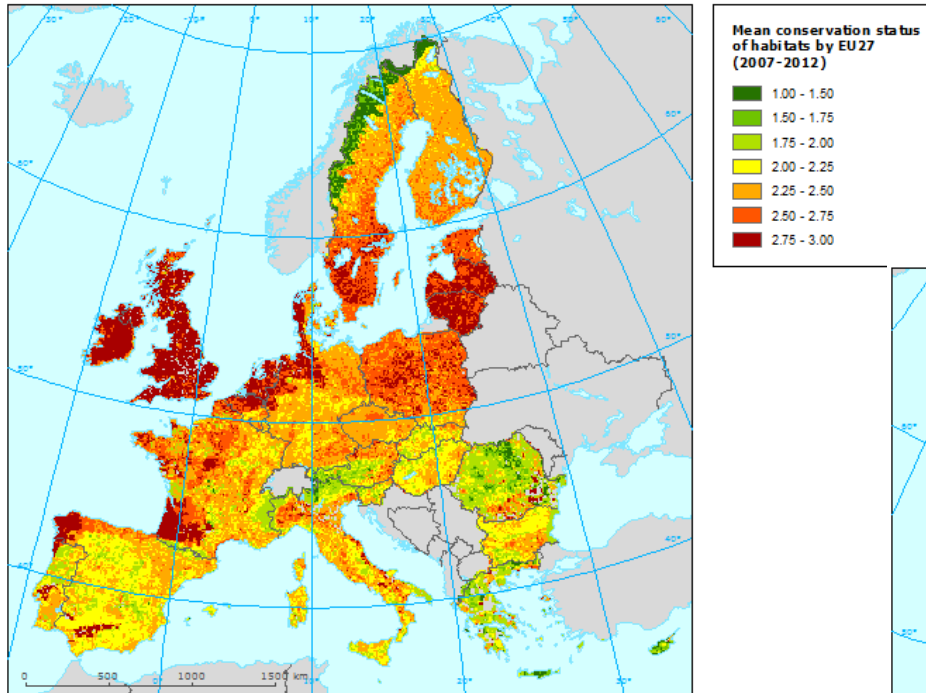

Mapping the Ecosystem Conditions

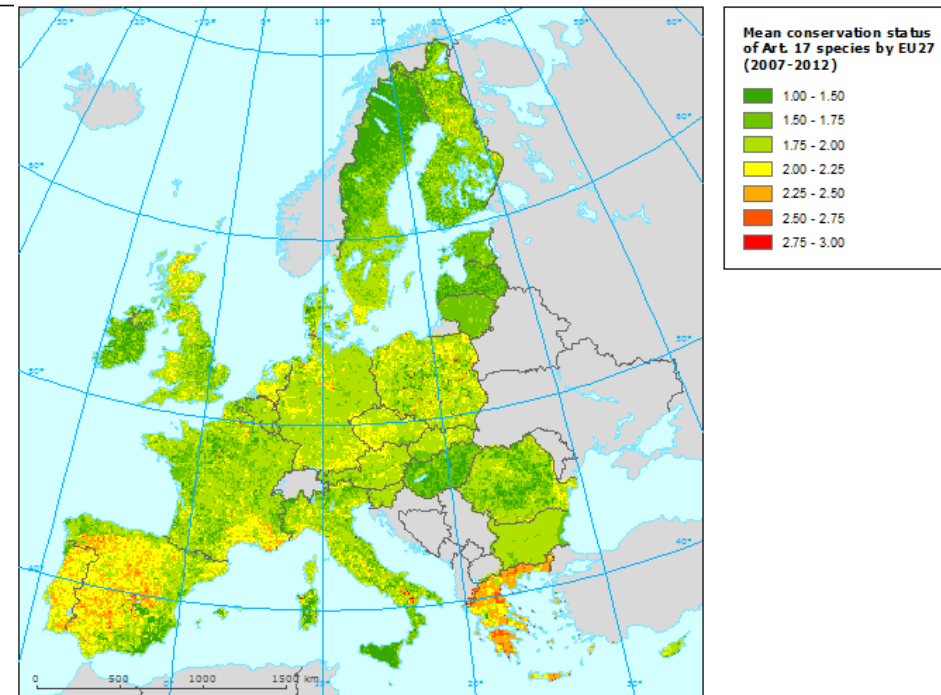
Reporting under the Habitats and Birds Directives

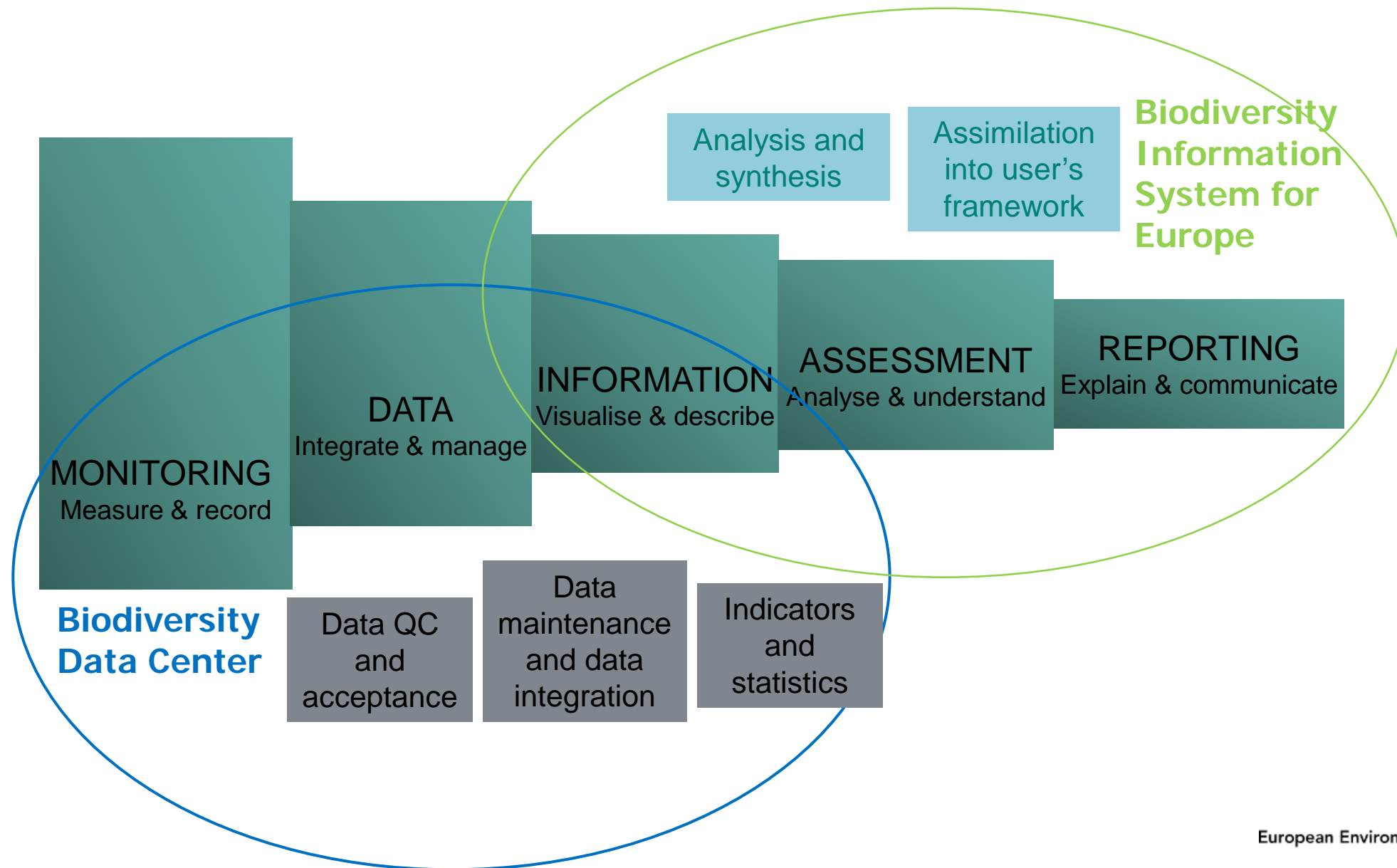

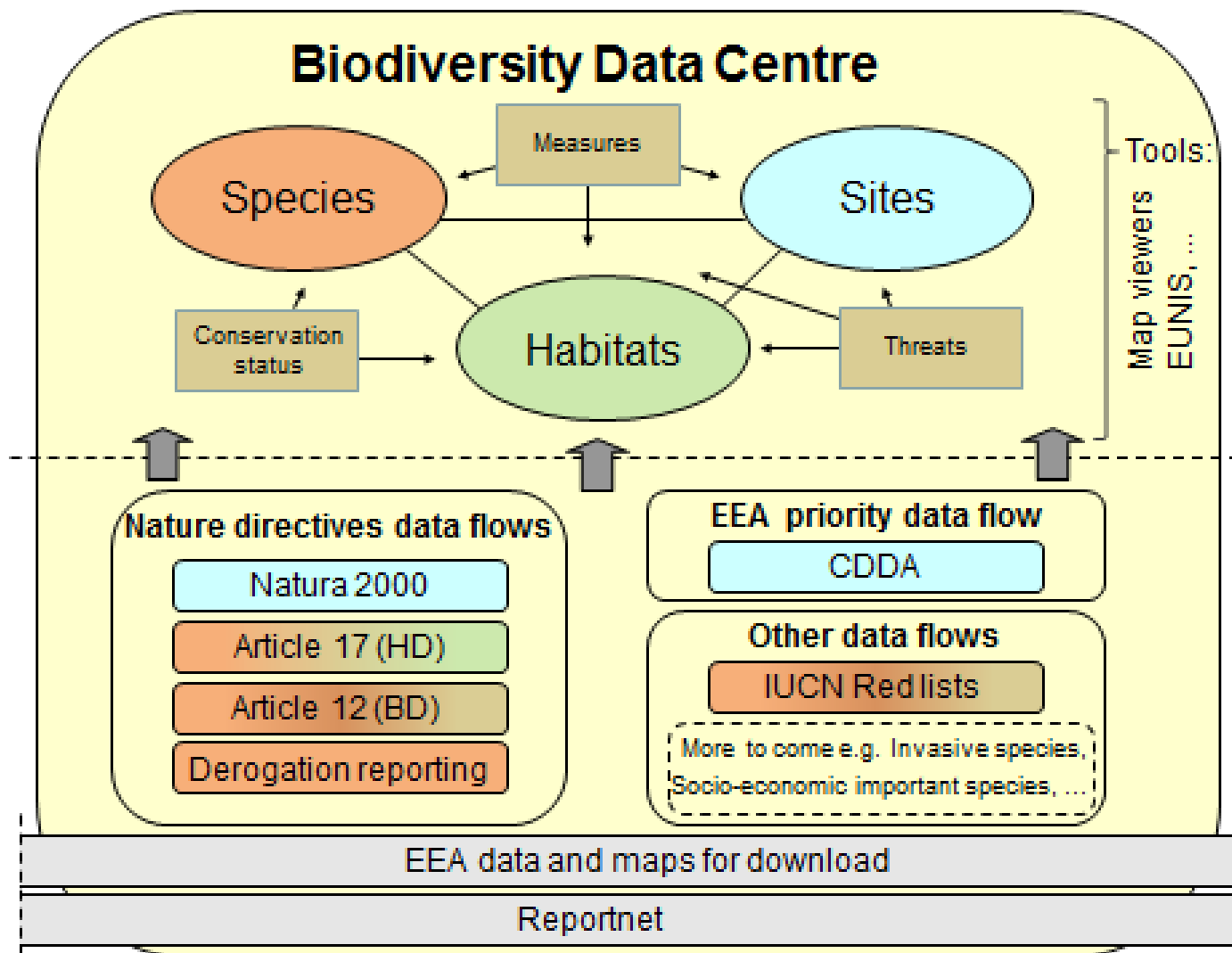
